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# THE RUMOUR MILL









## TERRIBLE LIZARDS CRUSH IRONCLADS IN PRE-SEASON (UN)FRIENDLY

Ironclads took The the earlv advantage, stunning the opponent's Kroxigor soon after kick-off, claiming the ball and constructing something of a cage around it; albeit a fairly brick-like one. Sadly, the team were unable to capitalise on it and a plucky Skink soon robbed them of the ball: the remainder of the first half was mostly typified by a series of brawls on or around the line of scrimmage with no clear victor emerging.

Synth Valley Renegades 1 - 1 P.O.S.



EARLY-GAME ACTION ON THE LINE OF SCRIMMAGE

#### ALL SQUARE IN THIS HOTLY CONTESTED BLACK ORC - SKAVEN MATCHUP

kick-off Following the Renegades, P.O.S. embarked on an eventful opening drive as Gutter Runner Snipz retrieves the ball and darts around the back line, shielded by a legion of Linerats and Storm Vermin standing firm in the face of the opposition. The Black Orcs come out swinging, punching multiple players to the ground and seizing a hole in the scrimmage formation; including Big Bite the Rat Ogre who is removed from play with a serious injury and some

light whisker bruising. The plucky Skaven held them off sufficiently to force an opening and, once free, the ball-carrier sprinted down the left wing with a clawful of Goblins in hot pursuit. Eventually caught by the ensuing Goblins and robbed of possession, the ball bounced up the pitch only to be picked up by the other Gutter Runner, who barrelled over the line for the first touchdown of the game. A short Black Orc drive follows the restart, before the half-time whistle is blown.

As the Skaven kick-off the second half, Big Bite stumbled back onto the pitch ready for round two but, with P.O.S missing three Linerats due to knockouts, the team were looking somewhat worse for wear. Despite being one goal down, the Renegades were able to substitute their one KO'd Goblin with their reserve in order to sport a full lineup for the second half.

To counter the impending Orc onslaught, Big Bite immediately began to deal out damage; spending most of the second half in a scuffle with a couple of Black Orcs, with blows exchanged back and forth. After collecting the ball, the Goblins formed a tight cage with support from their teammates and slowly began progressing towards the P.O.S.' endzone. The Skaven team does its best to slow them down and get in the way, but the strength of the Black Orcs eventually pushes through, helped by a couple more casualties inflicted on the fragile rats. A break allows a Goblin to race across the line, score a touchdown and secure a tight draw between the two teams.
